Croatia were way down at 36 in terms of the numbers of fouls committed by teams during qualifications, averaging 10.58 called on them in each match (Scotland were worst, averaging 16.92). They had the cleanest record for yellow cards, with only 7 against them during all of qualification, and they had no red cards.

Obviously you can't get a sense of a team's style of play from just statistics--there could be a lot of fouls that the ref didn't call--but they have a very clean record from the qualifiers evilC.
