Merlin and Rick, where and when did you see Hounslow play?

Their original ground, tucked away at the back of Denbigh Road has long gone and since then the club has had a number of unsuccessful reincarnations. They had a spell playing at the dismal Inwood Park while they were, I think, in the Middx County League. Then a merger with Feltham followed to create Feltham & Hounslow Borough FC, which lasted a season or so. I don't know what happened then, but the most recent incarnation was ended at the end of 2006/07 with the club going bust a year after winning the Hellenic East Division. Michael Meaker had been playing for them, which, although rewarded with plenty of goals, couldn't have helped their precarious financial position.
